Subject	Learning Challenge			
Maths	Summer 1 Week 1. Hunt the Minibeasts. This week's maths learning challenge I would like you to go outside and find as many Minibeasts as you can. When you have completed this, could you get a cup of water and use your finger to write the number of Minibeasts that you have found on the path. Why not trying to write your numbers 1-20 on the path and see if you can beat the sun before it dries the numbers away.			
Phonics	Your phonic focus for this week: please could you have a look through your reading book or your favourite book at home and find as many of our green and red words as you can find. Try and find them on the key word sheet you have in your pack.

Please start at red book 1. If they can read the words fluently and without sounding out, move onto the next colour set. Work through the sets in order, red, green, purple, pink and orange. Instructions are on each page.			
Writing	Can you draw a picture of your favourite Minibeast. Write sentences or words to go with your picture. Remember to sound out the words using your phonics. Please take a phot and send it to us using the email address/facebook page.			
The World	Can you make a Minibeast garden? Use a box, soil, twigs and leaves. Can you make a sign for your Minibeast garden? Remember to send your photos to us.			
Brambles Challenge	Can you gather one thing that starts with each letter of the alphabet and collect them on one dinner plate – nothing bigger. Send your photos in, I can't wait to see.
