<b>Reading</b>	Read a chapter of a book from home of your choice– either your own book or your school reading book. Can you summarise the chapter with the most important events that happen in under 50 words?
<b>Writing</b>	Your child has been asked to partake in the 100 word challenge based on four words: <b>You can (not) replay...</b> Your child has 100 words plus the 4 in the prompt to write a story. Really think hard about the words you use and don't forget to make your pieces as exciting and creative as possible.
<b>Wider Curriculum</b>	Research the life of Queen Victoria and create a timeline. This should include at least 10 interesting pieces of information about her.
