





# Brambles Primary Academy – Morning Nursery

Maths	<p>Number of the week 3. Phonics	<p>Please watch the daily Read Write Inc phonics session. <b>Set 1 9.30am</b>. Click link <a href="#">RWI Phonics</a></p> <p>The videos are available for 24hrs after being shown. We had learnt up to 'h' in Nursery. Can you make a 'm' collection of objects from your house? Send a photograph in to show me your collections.</p>
Reading	<p>Share a story with your child; this could be one from home, one from Oxford Owl <a href="https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/books/free-ebooks/">https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/books/free-ebooks/</a> or from Teach your Monster to Read. Writing	<p>Ask an adult to draw a medal shape for you (like the one below) – can you colour it in or decorate it for a soldier to wear? Or even once you have finished cut it out and ask an adult to take a photograph of you wearing it.</p>

Why not make some bunting to decorate your house or garden?
