Reading	<p>Listen to 'Don't worry Little Crab' https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/m000hs3d/cbeebies-bedtime-stories-752-tom-hardy-dont-worry-little-crab Talk about a time when you have felt worried about something or been brave. Do you remember how you felt?</p>
Writing	<p>Keep practicing your name writing? Ask an adult to write letters on pieces of paper so you can jumble your name and put it back together again. https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/tg-ga-180-rhyming-with-kit-level-1-phonics Watch this rhyming power point – can you draw a rhyming sentence – 'a cat in a hat' – can you draw a cat and a hat, can you think of other rhyming pairs?</p>
The World	<p>Set up an imaginative small world with mini figures, building blocks and your own trees and buildings made from paper and card.</p>
Getting School ready	<p>Memory Game - Collect ten small objects from around the house and put them on a tray. Ask the other person to look away while you take away one object. When they open their eyes, they guess what is missing.</p>
