<b>Maths</b> 	Summer 1 Week 6. Spider week This week's maths learning challenge is counting objects. Use some pegs from the washing line and paper to create a spider with 8 legs. Super Challenge! Can you find two numbers that add together to make 8 e.g. $4 + 4$ , $6 + 2$ ? Have fun!								
<b>Phonics</b> 	For your phonics learning this week can you focus on some spellings. I have put some red and green words. Challenge... <b>Reading</b> 	With help from an adult, find some 'spider facts' on the internet. Find out what spiders do and how important they are for the environment. When you have completed this can you write 3 facts down for you to share in the academy during show and tell or share with us on our Facebook page.								
<b>Writing</b> 	Can you make a printing spider? Use a cardboard tube and paint to print a spider. Don't forget to cut out (with adult help) the correct amount of legs. Remember how you done this, as I would like you to write down step – by – step instructions for this activity. Don't get too messy!								
<b>The World</b> 	When you are having fun in the garden or on your little walk, look out for spiders (like a real superhero Spiderman/woman) Look at the amazing webs they make, how they do this, what do the spiders eat and do they live underground?								
<b>Reception Challenge</b>	Encourage all your family to make a handprint. Either draw around the hand or print the hands. Find out who's is the biggest and smallest. Look at all the different lines on each other's hands.
