Subject	Learning Challenge
<b>Maths</b>	<p>Continue to practise your counting, this can be stairs, toys or stones in the garden. <b>Phonics</b>	<p>Please watch the daily Read Write Inc phonics session. <b>Set 1 9.30am</b>. <b>Reading</b>	<p>This week we are listening to 'Pirates Love Underpants', you can find this using the link <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Vd8_Y1bEzA8">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Vd8_Y1bEzA8</a> Encourage them to think about what is meant by 'value' and how things are valued for different reasons. Examples might be because they are loved or have sentimental value, because they have religious or spiritual meaning or because they are useful</p>
<b>Writing</b>	<p>Using coffee and water make your own 'paint', cover a piece of paper with the coffee paint you have made. Once it is dry make a map of where you would go if you were a pirate, don't forget to put you 'X' to show where your treasure is.</p>
<b>The World</b>	<p>On Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June it is 'International Mud Day', this day celebrates the fact that in this country we have access to clean water and also makes us think of children that do not have this. Plant some seeds, flowers, do some digging then wash your hands so they are clean – have fun in the mud!</p>
<b>Getting School ready</b>	<p>Think of your favourite nursery rhymes – we have sang lots and lots in Nursery. Practise 5 nursery rhymes.</p>
