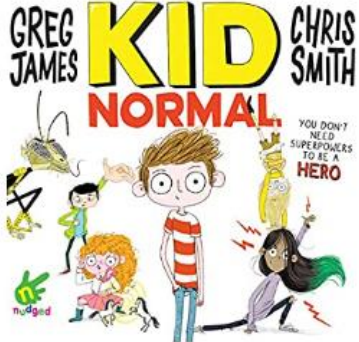

<b>Reading</b>	Using any leaflets, magazines, newspapers, take away menus you have at home, read them and pick out all of the nouns, verbs and adjectives you can find.
<b>Writing</b>	I am sure you are having lots of fun in your gardens, please write me a diary entry explaining all of the lovely things you have been doing over Easter. Email your diary to the address at the top of the page. I will look forward to reading about your adventures.
<b>Wider Curriculum</b>	Research the Vikings. Can you find out about how their lives were different from our lives today?
