





Brambles Primary Academy – Morning Nursery

Maths	<p>Number of the week 7. Watch Numberblocks The Number 7 https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b08pgqt4/numberblocks-series-2-seven</p> <p>Ask an adult to help you draw 4 fish, now can you colour them in using a 2 colour pattern.</p>  <div data-bbox="627 824 1240 925" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px;"> <p>Across the sky and down from heaven, Now I've made a number 7</p> </div>
Phonics	<p>Please watch the daily Read Write Inc phonics session. Set 1 9.30am. Click link RWI Phonics The videos are available for 24hrs after being shown. https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/29318.html Recap all of the letters learnt so far</p>
Reading	<p>Listen to the story 'Rainbow Fish'. Talk about what the fish did? Was it a good thing or a bad thing? Talk about something you could share?</p>
Writing	<p>Can you draw 3 pictures to go with the story of Rainbow fish? Ask an adult to write under each picture which part of the story it is. Remember to think about our story maps, draw something from the beginning, something from the middle and something from the end.</p>

Getting School ready	<p>Adults – write your child's name on pieces of paper around the house – child to find their name – recognising their own name in different contexts is so important ready for starting full time school as they will have more books, trays, coat pegs where they will need to be able to recognise their name.</p>
