

Subject	Learning Challenge
Maths	Summer 1 Week 5. Bee week This week's maths learning challenge is counting objects. Find objects around the house/garden and count them 1 by 1. Make sure you say each number name. When you have completed this can you write the number in the air, on paper or use chalk outside. When you go for a walk, find the numbers on the doors around the area. Enjoy!
Phonics I SPY	For your phonics learning this week play 'I SPY' with members of your family. When you have completed this, play a rhyming game. Find an object and see if family members can think of word that rhymes with it.
Reading	With help from an adult, find some 'bee facts' on the internet. Find out what bees do and how important they are for the environment. When you have completed this can you write 3 facts down for you to share in the academy during show and tell?
Writing	Can you make a shopping list for a family member to get ingredients to make 'honey sandwiches'? Have fun making them and most of all trying them. Yum! When you have completed this can you write down each step on how you made them to help someone else. Don't get too sticky!
The World	When you are having fun in the garden or on your little walk, look out for bees. Remember please don't hurt them as they are so important. Look at the patterns and details on them. Maybe plant some flowers to invite the bees into your garden.
Reception Challenge	Draw a picture of the members of your family. Encourage your family members to do the same. Don't forget to share your wonderful home learning with us. Take care and stay safe.
