Subject	Learning Challenge
Maths	Summer 1 Week 4. The very hungry caterpillar This week's maths learning challenge is looking at the days of the week, just like the 'Hungry Caterpillar'. Keep a diary of your week. Monday, 10 jumps. Tuesday, 20 claps. Wednesday, 15 hops. Thursday, 30 twirls. Friday, 5 star jumps. Saturday, touch toes. Sunday, your choice. Enjoy!
Phonics	For your phonics learning this week, visit the web site www.phonicsbloom.com . Work through the activities on your own and then challenge family members to see what sounds/words they know.
Reading Second Production Second	Watch the Very Hungry Caterpillar story on you tube. Listen very carefully to what happens in the story, especially the adjectives that is read out. From this story, can you make a mind map of the important things that the caterpillar does. Don't forget to add some adjectives. e.g. Crunchy apple.
Writing	Make a butterfly/caterpillar using cake cases or paper. Remember each step that you did. Writing challenge is to write some instructions on how you made it. This will help someone else to make one just like you when we return to the academy.
The World	When you are having fun in the garden or on your little walk, look out for butterflies/caterpillars and count how many you have found. If you get close enough (don't touch) look at the markings and colours on them.
Brambles Challenge	Look at some old family photographs, talk about how much you have grown up. Encourage other family members to help you make a family tree using some photographs. Please take photos and send them into the academy.
