Maths	Continue to practise your 3, 4, 7 and 8 times tables. Thinking about your list of 3 dimensional shapes from last week, can you describe their properties using the following mathematical vocabulary – edges, vertices, faces (use your 2d shape knowledge when describing the faces). Can you put this information into a table?
Reading	If you have access to the internet at home. Do an Internet search on the Vikings, find at least 5 facts/information about them.
Writing	Write a letter to an NHS worker thanking them for their amazing hard work during this challenging time. Try to include at least 3 paragraphs including an introduction to explain who you are and why you are writing to them, a main paragraph listing what you are grateful for and a final paragraph to tell them what you have been doing to stay safe at home.
Wider Curriculum	In Science, we were going to focus on Light. At home, can you find as many light sources as you can? For example, a phone screen, computer...Try and list 10 different sources of light.
Challenge	Each day this week, we would like you to choose a colour and find as many things as you can which are that colour. You can look in your home and garden and on your daily walk for inspiration. For example, on Monday look for anything that is the colour red and take photos or write them down. On Tuesday, look for everyday items that are the colour blue.
