

Subject	Learning Challenge								
Maths 	Summer Week 9 The lighthouse keepers lunch This week's maths learning challenge is counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. You could use your fingers, steps and movements to help you with this. Ask an adult or older sibling to help you to start. Try your best to get to 50. You are a super star if you can count in 2's, 5's, 10's to 100. Enjoy! Have a look at the 100 grid to help. If you have access to a printer you could print it off and colour the 2's in one colour 5's in another and 10's in another. You should see a pattern.								
Phonics 	For your phonics learning this week can you focus on some spellings. I have put some red and green words. Challenge... Reading 	Have a look on the internet if you have not got a copy of 'The lighthouse keepers lunch'. Listen to the story and join in if you are familiar with it. Look out for some of them cheeky 'red words' and 'green words'.								
Writing 	For your writing challenge, this week. Can you make a sandwich like the Lighthouse keepers wife? When you have made it, can you write down all the ingredients you used and steps of how you made it? Yummy, enjoy you super sandwich. Maybe go on a picnic with the sandwich you have made.								
The World 	Ask an adult in your family about the important job that a Lighthouse does. Ask them questions like Why is the lighthouse there and where will I find one. If you have some plastic cups, tape and battery candle. You could make a lighthouse of your own, like the picture.								
Reception Challenge 	As the summer is here. Ask an adult to help you make a paper fan to keep cool. Remember to keep safe in the sun! Put cream and hat on, sit in the shade and drink often.
