Subject	Learning Challenge									
<div>Maths</div> <div></div>	<div>Place value</div> <p>We know about tens and ones in numbers. We know to write t and o above a number to help us see the number. Can you practice this more at home?</p> <p>Get an adult to give you a number (you can use the random generator we used before) and make the tens and ones with different items. Be creative you could use a fork as tens because its long and a tea spoon because it's shorter or use a pen as a ten and a rubber as ones. You could even make a number and get an adult to work out what it is.</p> <div> = 34 (3 tens and 2 ones)</div> <p>We are getting the hang of our times tables now. Keep practicing. Remember to use times tables rock stars. This week we are practicing out 5 times tables. If you feel like you are a wiz with these you can start to look at your 3 but keep going with your 5 if you are not ready.</p>									
<div>Reading</div> <div></div>	<div>Slowly slowly slowly said the sloth.</div> <p>Slowly that's how the sloth lives. He hangs upside-down from the branch of a tree, night and day, in the sun and in the rain, while the other animals of the rain forest rush past him. Read this story or use youtube to listen to the story. From here, can you write another sentence to describe how another animal from the rainforest lives? For example, the jaguar is very fast, the gorilla is very strong and the toucan is very colourful. What sentences could do with these animals or others you know?</p>									
<div>Writing</div> <div></div>	<p>The rainforest is an amazing place. It is home to so many different type of animals, some of which you may not have even heard of previously. Can you use the internet or books to find out about these?
