Subject	Learning Challenge		
Maths	Can you draw a flower with 8 petals – can you draw 4 petals red, how many petals do you have left? You can choose a colour for the petals that are left over.		
	When you are outside look at your shadow, is it the same size as you? Is it bigger or is it smaller? Look at your Mum or Dads shadow? Is theirs bigger or smaller than yours? Ask an adult to draw around your shadow using chalk.		
Phonics	Please watch the daily Read Write Inc phonics session. Set 1 9.30am . Click link RWI Phonics The videos are available for 24hrs after being shown. https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/29318.html Can you find 5 objects beginning with 's', draw a picture for each.

Writing	Make a list of things you would like to do in the school holidays – draw a picture next to each thing on your list.		
Physical Development	Sticky Kids – Join in with music and movement on youtube Using boxes, blocks or anything you can find – make a tower as tall as yourself. Send me a photograph so I can see your towers so tall!		
Getting School ready	This is your last week of Nursery before you start your reception journey – this week try getting yourself ready, practice carrying your own bag, putting your shoes on and off, fastening your coat – all the things you will need to be able to do for September. If you go anywhere over the holidays make sure you collect leaflets, stones, photographs to bring into school in September to show your new teachers.
