

# Welcome back

We are writing to you following our first few weeks back in the academy, as it is a new way of working for us all. We appreciate your patience and support as we work together to ensure the academy operates as smoothly and safely as possible.

We will be working to keep the children within their class/year group bubbles in order to minimise mixing across the academy. Government guidance states that children do not need to socially distance, but staff should work to keep a distance as much as possible. This will be very challenging, especially with the youngest of our pupils, and whilst we will work to minimise contact to keep distance – the welfare of the children will be our priority and we will strive to keep them feeling safe and happy.

#### Hygiene

Regular 20 second handwashing will happen throughout the day - children will wash hands each time they enter/leave a room, before and after playtime and lunchtime, before and after they use the toilet, and regularly through the day.

We have appointed additional cleaners throughout the day – so handles, surfaces and toilets will be cleaned regularly. At lunchtimes, all tables and surfaces will be cleaned after each year group has eaten. Anti-bac spray/ wipes are always available within the classrooms for use by staff and children as necessary. Windows will be open to provide good ventilation through school.

#### **Reading Books**

All reading books will be sent home with children on a Monday and should only be returned on a Friday. This is so that we can quarantine them over the weekend before being put safely back on the shelves. Parents are asked to support our reading wherever possible by sharing books with children each night.

#### **Breakfast and After school clubs**

Due to government, guidelines there will be no after school clubs or breakfast club at least this half term. This will be reviewed as further updates are received by the DfE.



## **Classroom Arrangements**

Whilst it is impossible to social distance young pupils, we have put in place a variety of measures to ensure that classrooms are COVID secure. Handwashing occurs regularly and equipment will not be shared between children.

Children further up school will be seated facing the front of the classroom and group work will not take place at this time.

#### **Playtimes**

Playtimes and lunchtimes will be staggered again so children remain in their class bubbles throughout the day.

Children will have many opportunities to socialise and make friends during the school day. However, due to social distancing rules this will be with their year group.

#### Uniform

It has been lovely to see all the children in their new uniforms returning to the academy this term. May we politely remind parents of the uniform code which is as follows:

Black school shoes – NO trainers please.

Haircuts should be appropriate – no shaved heads or lines.

Simple bobbles / ribbons / slides in school colours – no large bows.

No nail varnish, hair dye, make up or spray tans.

The new tartan skirts and pinafores can be purchased from Lollipops.

### Messages to the office.

In order to minimise traffic around the academy we ask that you keep any visits to the office to a minimum. We do however understand that there maybe times when you need to speak to them in person.




# **Dropping off and picking up times/lunchtime arrangements**
