

Brambles Primary Academy COVID update

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the recent announcement that we will be entering Tier 2 of COVID restrictions on Wednesday 14th October we would like to advise you how this will effect you in the community:

These are the Tier 2 restrictions from Wednesday:

- You cannot have people you do not live with over to your house
- You cannot visit anyone else's house
- You cannot socialise with anyone outside your household in pubs, restaurants or any other indoor setting
- You can still meet up to six people in a private garden or public outdoor setting, such as a park
- Social distancing and the 10pm curfew will be maintained

Over the past few months, we have worked incredibly hard to ensure that we keep our staff and children as safe as possible during this pandemic. In order to prevent any outbreaks wherever possible we have taken the decision to implement the following rules:

1. Please ensure that only **one person drops off or collects your children each day**. We ask that you do not bring any secondary pupils on site during this time. This is to limit the number of visitors and minimize the contact between groups.
2. Wherever possible, we would advise **the use of masks whilst on site**.
3. Please support the school by following government guidelines and not socialising in the community or having sleep overs/parties in the coming weeks. We ask this so that we can keep the children as safe as possible and prevent bubbles being contaminated.

I appreciate this may cause slight inconvenience for some, however until this pandemic is over we have no option but to remain alert and follow recommended guidelines in order to ensure our pupils are safe at school. Brambles Primary Academy thank you for your continued support during this time.
